CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION OF SINS:

I John 1:7---2:2 (KJV)

- P: The blood of Jesus Christ His Son
- C: Cleanses us from all sin.
- P: If we say that we have no sin,
- C: We deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- P: If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins,
- C: And to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- P: If we say that we have not sinned,
- C: We make Him a liar, and His Word is not in us.
- P: My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate [spokesman] with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous,
- C: And He is the propitiation [payment] for our sins, and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
- P: As King David said to the prophet Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD," Nathan said to David, "The LORD also has put away your sin. You shall not die (II Samuel 12:13)!

EPISTLE: I Corinthians 12:1-11 Paul speaks of the working of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit works in direct opposition to the spirits of Satan. Satan's spirits seek to lead people to despise Christ, turning them to idols. The Holy Spirit leads people TO Jesus, trusting Him for salvation. Trust, or faith, is His gift. He gives additional blessings to Christians as He wills, to fit the need at

hand, for the benefit of all. Gifts He gives today are not the same as gifts He gave at the apostles' time. Use your gifts given by the Holy Spirit. Use them to proclaim salvation in Jesus. Strive to work in harmony with your brothers and sisters in Christ in our congregation. Just as the parts of the body function as one, so let the church function as one.

GOSPEL: Luke 19:41-48. As Jesus approached Jerusalem (Palm Sunday), He wept over Jerusalem and its stubborn inhabitants. The leaders had disregarded His Father's Word and had despised the prophets. They misused His Father's house. They were seeking to destroy Jesus, the Father's Son. However, destruction would come upon them! Others were clinging to Jesus' words in simple faith. --- Trust Jesus for forgiveness and eternal blessing!
