# LORD, SPARE THE RIGHTEOUS FROM THE DOOM OF THE TWISTED

And the Lord said, "Because the outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grave, I will go down now and see whether they have done altogether according to the outcry against it that has come to Me; and if not, I will know." Then the men turned away from there and went toward Sodom, but Abraham still stood before the Lord. And Abraham came near and said, "Would You also destroy the righteous with the wicked? Suppose there were fifty righteous within the city; would You also destroy the place and not spare it for the fifty righteous that were in it? Far be it from You to do such a thing as this, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous should be as the wicked; far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?" So the Lord said, "If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes."

Then Abraham answered and said, "Indeed now, I who am but dust and ashes have taken it upon myself to speak to the Lord: Suppose there were five less than the fifty righteous; would You destroy all of the city for lack of five?" So He said, "If I find there forty-five, I will not destroy it." And he spoke to Him yet again and said, "Suppose there should be forty found there?" So He said, "I will not do it for the sake of forty." Then he said, "Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak: Suppose thirty should be found there?" So He said, "I will not destroy it for the sake of twenty." Then he said, "Let not the Lord be angry, and I will speak but once more: Suppose ten should be found there?" # CLC CONVENTION ACTIONS—PREACHING CHRIST 2022-2024:

- ---Re-elected: President Mike Eichstadt, Vice-President Mike Wilke, Secretary Wayne Eichstadt.
- ---Budget: Money from the Reserve Fund will be used to meet the shortfall in the 2021-2022 budget. Caution will be needed going forward.
- ---New Board: A separate Board for Education was authorized. It is charged with encouraging and assisting congregations investigating beginning a school, starting a school, or operating with an existing school.
- ---CLC-WELS-ELS: The points of doctrinal difference on the teaching of terminating church fellowship, points which were drawn up during the past year by the CLC Committee (in place of the Joint Statement), will be forwarded to the WELS and ELS for their agreement or disagreement.
- ---Board of Doctrine Involvement Whenever Doctrinal Discussions Are Taking Place with Another Church Body. Should it be mandatory? The majority voted No. It was felt such a restriction would bind the hands of the President.
- ---New Gymnasium: Plans for a new gymnasium at ILC were viewed and discussed. Cost estimates are in the \$14 million range. A building committee was authorized. No work shall begin until funding is secured. Additional project would be a fine arts / chapel building to replace the old gymnasium-cost perhaps another \$3 million.
