SERMON: Ephesians 4: 22-32

**TAKE OFF THE OLD, THE RUINED --
PUT ON THE NEW, THE FRESH!**

... Put off, concerning your former conduct, the **old man** which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and [that you] put on the **new man** which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

1) Therefore, putting away **lying**, "Let each one of you speak truth with his neighbor," for we are members of one another. 2) "Be **angry**, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil. 3) Let him who stole **steal** no longer, but rather let him labor, working with his hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need. 4) Let no **corrupt word** proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. 5) And do not **grieve the Holy Spirit** of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. 6) Let all **bitterness**, wrath, anger, clamor, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice.

7) And be **kind to one another**, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.
