SERMON: Psalm 119:113-120

The Hebrew alphabet has twenty-two letters. Psalm 119 has twenty-two sections, one for each letter. Each section has eight lines. All eight lines of a section begin with the same Hebrew letter. Verses 113-120 each begin with “samek,” the fifteenth letter of the Hebrew alphabet (“s” sound.) This psalm pattern is called an alphabetical acrostic. English translations do not reflect the pattern.
