Hymn 3 Lord Jesus Christ, Be Present Now!

EPISTLE: Galatians 3:15-22 God had promised Abraham that through Abraham's Seed all people on earth would be blessed. Abraham believed this promise—the promise of the Savior of all the world! Years later, God also gave Abraham's descendants, the Israelites, His Law and His Commandments at Mt. Sinai taking them as His people. The Law and the Commandments did not replace the promise of the Savior to come, or provide an alternate way to get to heaven. The Law of God hedges-in sinners, showing them that they are sinners in *need* of a Savior. Christ is the Savior!

PSALM 85, p. 40 Lord, You Have Been Favorable!

GOSPEL Luke 10:25-37 A certain Pharisee, a self-righteous man and an expert in the requirements of Old Testament Law, asked Jesus how to get to heaven. The man knew the Old Testament command to love the Lord totally and to love one's neighbor as oneself. What he didn't see was that he had not done these things! To help him, Jesus told the parable of the Good Samaritan, in which a non-Jew helped a sorely beaten Jew. Jesus wanted the Pharisee to see that if he thought he already loved God and his neighbor sufficiently to get to heaven, then he needed to love Samaritans too! ----- Could the man see that he needed a Savior?

APOSTLES' CREED

SERMON: JOHN 6 (selected verses 26-35, 51b-57, 63b-64a, 67-69) GETTING HIS BREAD, INTO YOUR HEAD!

Jesus answered them and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. Do not labor [work] for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him." Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?" Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

Therefore. they said to Him, "What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do? Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.' " Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always." And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst. . . . the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world."

The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?" Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.

The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. But there are some of you who do not believe. . . . Then Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you also want to go away?" But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."
