EPISTLE: I Thessalonians 4:1-8 Paul instructs his readers to live sanctified lives, separate from sin and the sinful world, in particular to avoid sexual immorality which is a rejection of God. Live in order to please God!

GOSPEL: Matthew 15:21-28 Jesus, at times, withdrew from Judea and Galilee to avoid opposition from the Jewish leaders. On one occasion He was with His disciples in the region of Tyre and Sidon outside the land of the Jews. A Canaanite woman approached Him. The Canaanites had lived in the land of Israel before Israel conquered the land by God's doing. The Canaanites were idol worshipers. This woman's daughter was grievously possessed by a demon. Jesus seemed to treat her very rudely, but she demonstrated such humble faith and trust in Jesus, her Lord and Savior. Jesus praised her faith and granted her request. ----- Jesus has come for all.

SERMON: HEBREWS 2:5-11

LOW, YET LOFTY---SERVANT, YET SAVIOR

He has not put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels. But [as] one testified in a certain place saying:

*What is man that You are mindful of him,
Or the son of man [the Son of Man] that You take care of him?
You have made him [for] a little lower than the angels;
You have crowned him with glory and honor,
And set him over the works of Your hands.
You have put all things in subjection under his feet. [Psalm 8]*

For, in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him. But we see Jesus, who was made [for] a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren.
