THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

From Martin Luther, 1529

What can a person do if he is not aware of his burden of sin and does not feel hunger and thirst [feels no need] for Holy Communion?

(PART 1 Previous bulletin: Does he still **have flesh and blood?** By all means believe what the Scriptures say about it: *Romans* 7:18 *Galatians* 5:17, 19-21).

(PART 2 Previous bulletin: Does he still **live in the world?** By all means believe what the Scriptures say about it: *John 15:18-20 Matthew 24:9-13 Acts 14:22*).

PART 3: He will certainly have the devil also about him, who with his lying and murdering, day and night, will let him have no peace within or without, as the Scriptures picture him.

John 8:44 He [the devil] is a liar and the father of it.

I Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

Ephesians 6:11-12 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places

II Timothy 2;25-26 ... in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.
