EPISTLE: James 1:16-21 The Father in heaven is kind and steadfast. He gives to our spirits new life in Jesus. In keeping with this new life, we offer ourselves to Him as firstfruits, just as the Old Testament believers brought the harvest firstfruits to the Lord. Let us cast anger and moral filth aside.

GOSPEL: John 21:15-25 After Jesus rose from the dead, He appeared to His disciples who were fishing at the Sea of Galilee. By Jesus' power, their net was filled with large fish. By Jesus' power, breakfast was waiting for them on the shore. After the breakfast,, Jesus specifically addressed Peter. It was Peter

who three times had denied that he even knew Jesus. Jesus asked Peter three times, "Do you love Me?" The third time used a lesser word for "love"—on the order of, "Peter, do you even *like* Me?" Peter humbly responded in repentance, "Lord, You know that I love you." Jesus replied each time to Peter, "Feed My sheep." Jesus re-instated Peter. --- With the same forgiveness, He re-instates you as His child, each time you sin.

SERMON: JOHN 15:1-6
THE VINE AND THE BRANCHES

I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes [cleans], that it may bear more fruit.

You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine; you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.
