**EPISTLE: I Corinthians 1:4-9.** Through His Word, God has blessed us with His grace (His undeserved love and pardon) in Christ. During this life, we eagerly await Jesus' return on that Last Day, when we will be found blameless! God, who has called us to faith, is faithful. He will keep us safe in Christ.

**GOSPEL Matthew 22:34-46.** Jesus' enemies with their shallow wisdom tried to trap Jesus in His words. They asked Him which commandment was the greatest. Jesus answered: "Love the Lord with all your heart, soul, and mind." Jesus then asked *them* a question: "Whose son is the Messiah?" They said, "The son of David," saying nothing about "Son of God." Jesus directed them to the Old Testament passage which states that the Messiah, David's "son," would also be David's Lord! The enemies did not respond. They did not want to admit that the Promised Messiah would be in fact <u>both</u> Son of God <u>and</u> son of man. That description fit Jesus and His miraculous power perfectly-- which they did not want to acknowledge. They were not so wise.

#### SERMON: II Chronicles 34:14-28 (selected verses) HOW COULD IT BE LOST ?!?

Then Hilkiah [the Priest] answered and said to Shaphan the scribe, "I have found the Book of the Law in the house of the Lord." And Hilkiah gave the book to Shaphan. So Shaphan carried the book to the king [King Josiah], bringing the king word, saying, ... "Hilkiah the priest has given me a book." And Shaphan read it before the king.

Thus it happened, when the king heard the words of the Law, that he tore his clothes. Then the king commanded Hilkiah, . . . "Go, inquire of the LORD for me, and for those who are left in Israel and Judah, concerning the words of the book that is found; for great is the wrath of the LORD that is poured out on us, because our fathers have not kept the Word of the LORD, to do according to all that is written in this book."

So Hilkiah and those the king had appointed went to Huldah the prophetess, . . . Then she answered them, Thus says the LORD God of Israel, Tell the man who sent you to Me, Thus says the LORD: "Behold, I will bring calamity on this place and on its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book which they have read before the king of Judah, because they have forsaken Me and burned incense to other gods, that they might provoke Me to anger with all the works of their hands. Therefore My wrath will be poured out on this place, and not be quenched."

But as for the king of Judah, who sent you to inquire of the Lord, in this manner you shall speak to him, Thus says the Lord God of Israel: "Concerning the words which you have heard— because your heart was tender, and you humbled yourself before God when you heard His words against this place and against its inhabitants, and you humbled yourself before Me, and you tore your clothes and wept before Me, I also have heard you, says the Lord. Surely I will gather you to your fathers, and you shall be gathered to your grave in peace; and your eyes shall not see all the calamity which I will bring on this place and its inhabitants."
