OPENING PRAYER

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION *[washing away]* **OF SINS:**

Luke 18:9-14

P: He *[Jesus]* spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

C: Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector.

P: The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank You that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers,

C: Or even as this tax collector. I fast *[skip food]* **twice a week. I give tithes** *[a tenth to God]* **of all that I possess.**

P: And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying,

C: God, be merciful to me a sinner.

P: I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *[declared not guilty]* rather than the other.

C: For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

To helpless humble sinners, by God's mercy in Christ, you are forgiven!

P: Oh, sing to the LORD a new song!

C: Sing to the LORD, all the earth.

P: Sing to the LORD, bless His name;

C: Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

P: For the LORD *is* great and greatly to be praised;

GOSPEL: Matthew 28:16-20 During forty days after His resurrection, Jesus appeared to His disciples. On a mountain in Galilee, He told them He had all power and would be with them always. He told them Go to all nations, make disciples (students) of them, baptize them in the name of the Triune God, and teach them all things. Baptism—the water and the Word! Bringing to sinful hearts the washing of forgiveness. A precious Means of Grace—a “tool” by which forgiveness in Christ comes to sinners. Part of mission work.

Sunday School: “Baptism Is a Wondrous Blessing!”

EPISTLE: Romans 10:11-15 Forgiveness and eternal life in Christ are not things that a person can manufacture for himself. They cannot be bought at a price. Rather, forgiveness and eternal life come to us as a message of pardon to which sin-burdened hearts cling in trust, faith, belief. The Message does not just come of itself. It needs to be proclaimed!
