EPISTLE: Acts 2:1-13 (KJV) The First Christian Pentecost ("Fiftieth" Day) --In the Old Testament, 50 days were counted from the weekend of Passover Feast to mark the end of grain harvest. On that day, offerings of the firstfruits of the grain harvest were presented. ---- Jesus rose from the grave on the Sunday of Passover week. On the 40th day, before He ascended into heaven, Jesus promised His disciples He would send them the Holy Spirit. Ten days later, on 50th Day—or Pentecost—He poured out the promised Holy Spirit. With boldness and understanding, speaking languages they had never studied, they proclaimed Jesus of Nazareth, the crucified and risen Savior from sin, to all those in Jerusalem for the Feast. 3000 were baptized and added to the Believers that day! This. the first *Christian* Pentecost, marks the beginning of the New Testament Church. ----- May the Lord continue to send the Holy Spirit to His church today, so that we clearly and boldly proclaim salvation in Jesus!
