THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY COMMUNION

The word *communion* is related to the word *community*—that is, "many together as one." This building is in the *community* of Lemmon. The word "communion" is also used in the Apostles' Creed to refer to the one group of all who trust in Christ for forgiveness and heaven—that is, the Holy Christian Church, or the *Communion* of Saints (believers). Also the Sacrament of the Altar is called *Communion* because it brings sinners together into a precious oneness with Christ the Savior. By a miracle beyond our understanding, He grants to each partaker the very purchase price of their rescue/redemption—His true body and His true blood. We are safe! To be in one with Jesus, the Lamb or God offered for our sins, is a most blessed *Communion*.
