EPISTLE: I Corinthians 4:1-5 The Lord will judge on the Last Day. In life, one person cannot really judge another person's heart or motives. The Lord is the Judge. Everyone is answerable only to God. Each one is God's servant / steward. Christ will expose each man's heart--a heart that holds to Jesus in faith or not—and at the Last Day will judge accordingly. SERMON: MARK 1:1-8
FOR ADVENT FEARS, GOD IS GRACIOUS!

The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God:

As it is written in the Prophets— [Malachi 3:1] Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, who will prepare Your way before You.

[Isaiah 40:3]. The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the LORD, make His paths straight’

John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins.
